



Home Screen

- To reach the home screen, click the home button on the bottom of the phone (see fig. 1)
- This is where all your apps are located. If you swipe to the left or right, there may be additional apps.
- Click on an app icon to open it




Contacts

- The Contacts app holds a collection of saved phone numbers and email addresses.
- To create a contact, first open the Contacts app by clicking on the below icon in your home screen:




Making Contacts Step 2



Click on any category to provide information about the contact. For example, click "First Name" to provide the contact's first name. Click "Add phone" to add a phone number for your contact, and "add email" to add an email address.





Scroll down to add more information (birthdays, nicknames, etc.)



block.




Calling Contacts Step 1

To call a contact, first go to the **Phone app**




Click the contacts

After clicking on the contact, scroll to the bottom of the page and click "Block this Caller." Click the "Block


up button to

confirm.





with a label of
"Spam Risk,"
"Scam Likely," or.
"Potential Scam."




Additionally, look for unfamiliar locations or area codes at the beginning of the number (i.e. 123 instead of 713)


Blocking Random Numbers Part 2 Click the Recents "Block this +1 (626) 223-5830 Caller" button. Click "Block Contact" on 10:58 AM Missed Call Share Contact the pop-up Create New Contact Add to Existing Contact button to Add to Emergency Contacts confirm. You Share My Location should no longer receive Block this Caller calls from this number

To block a random number, open the **Phone app** and click the Recents tab at the bottom. Then, click on the 'i' icon next to the number you would like to block

corner of the


screen once you
