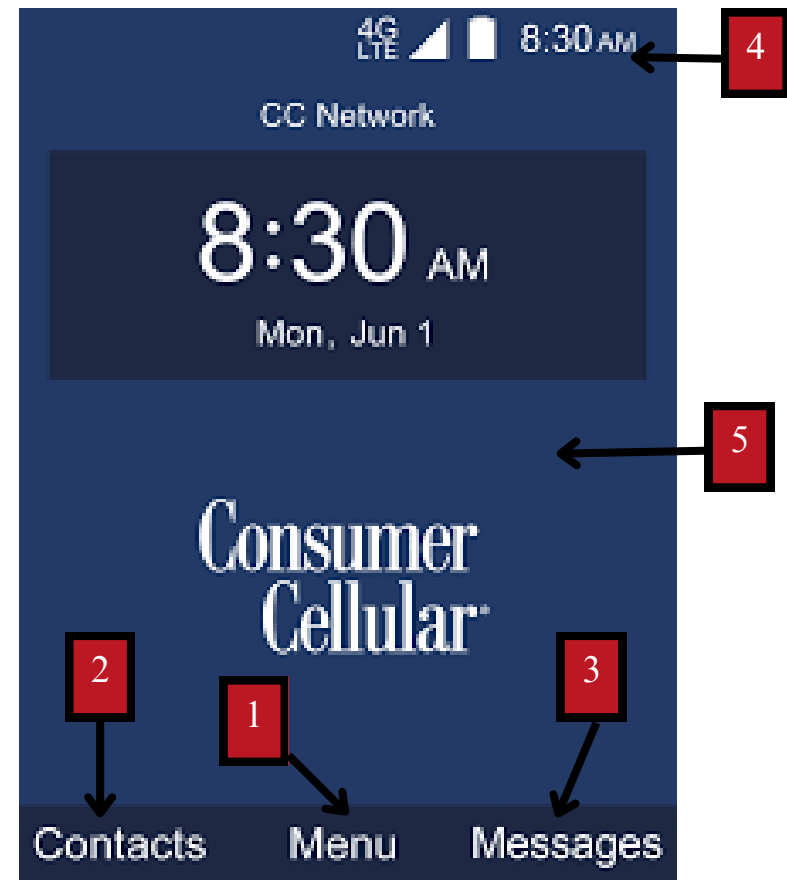

1. Click the "Menu" Button at the bottom of your screen to open the app menu, where all of your applications are displayed.
2. Click the "Contacts" button at the bottom of your screen to open the list of your contacts.
3. Click the "Messages" button at the bottom of your screen to open your messages.
4. Examine the top bar of your screen to view your remaining battery life and network connection.
5. The screen behind the text on your home screen is your wallpaper. Later in the book, we will explain how to set this screen to a custom image.

Exterior Phone Elements 5

1. **Camera:** The lens used to take photos.
2. **Volume Up Key:** Click on this button to raise the volume
3. **Volume Down Key:** Click on this button to decrease the sound.
4. **External Display:** Shows the time and battery life of the device.
5. **Charging Jack:** Plug in your device here to charge it.

Interior Phone Elements 7

1. **4-way Navigation Key:** Click the top of the key to move the cursor on your screen.
2. **OK Key:** Click this to select the item under your cursor.
3. **Call Key:** Click this to place or answer a call or view your call history.
4. **Camera Key:** Click this key to take a picture or record a video.
5. **Vibration Mode Key:** Press and hold in the home screen to turn on vibration mode, so your phone vibrates instead of making a noise when called.
6. **Clear Key:** Press to delete text.
7. **Power/End Key:** Press and hold to power the phone off or press to end or reject a call.

Opening Applications Step 1 9

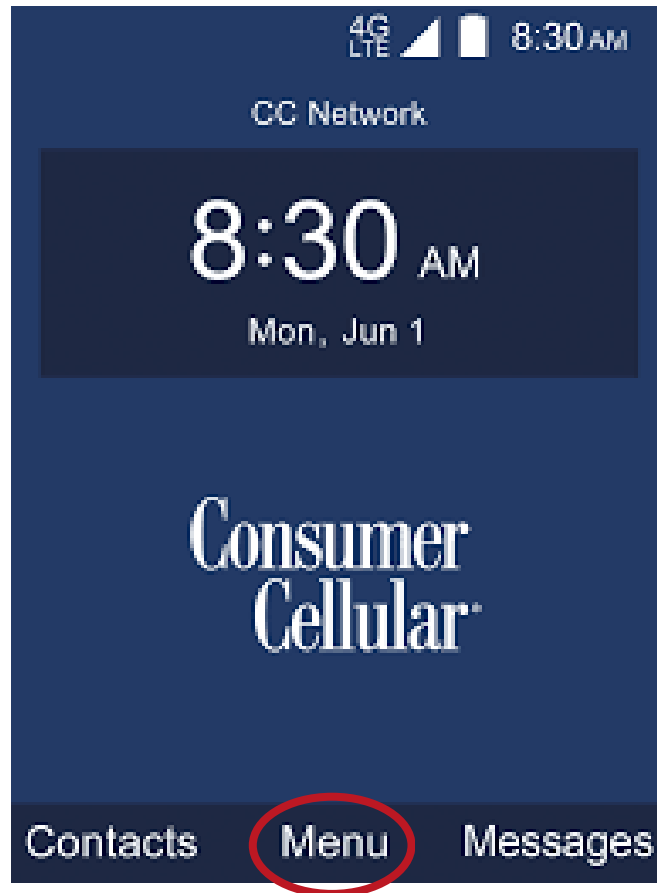

3. Once you have selected the app of your choice, press on the OK key (described on pg. 7-8) to open the application.

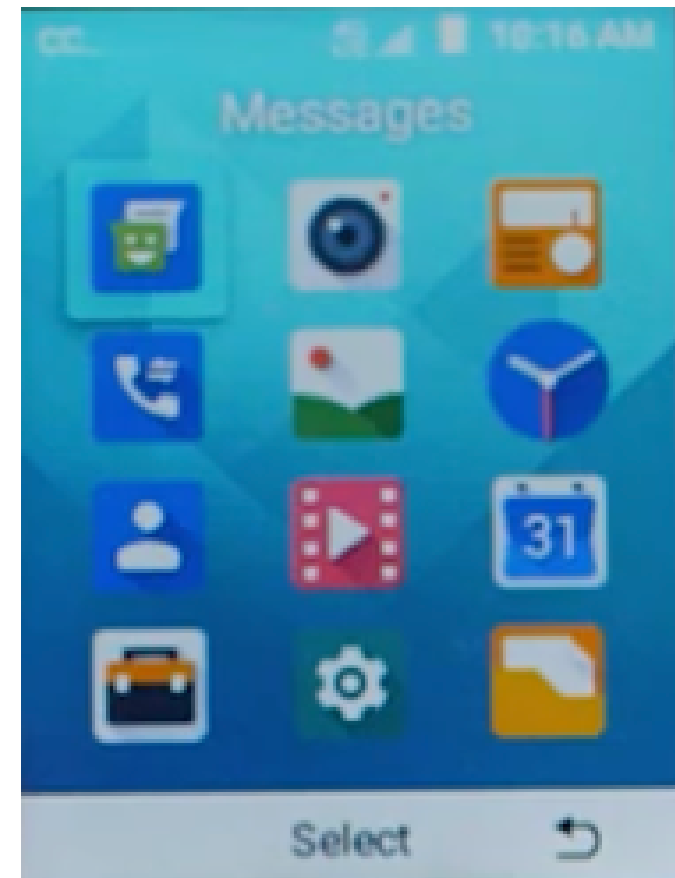

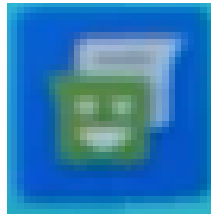

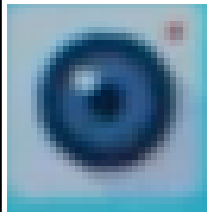

Calls: This app displays a log of the calls that you have sent and received.

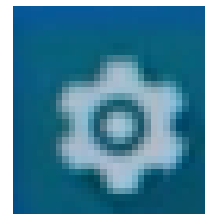

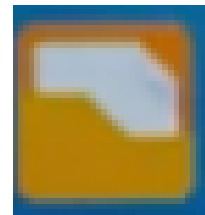
Calendar: This app displays your events schedule on different dates.



Tools Menu: This app contains helpful tools such as a calculator.

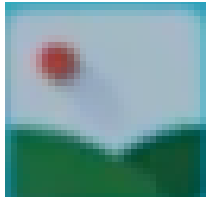


Settings Menu: This app allows access to numerous system setting.

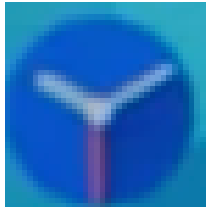


File Manager: This app provides you with access to your saved files.

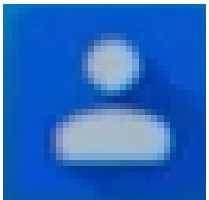

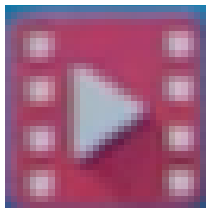
Gallery: Your photos and videos are stored in this app.



Clock: Here you can set alarms and stopwatches.

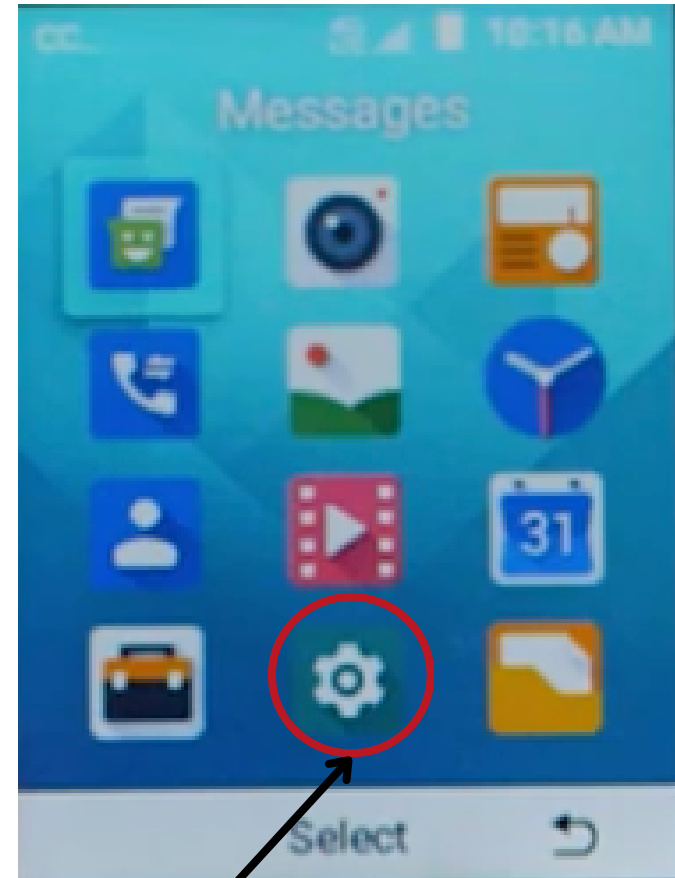


Contacts: This app displays a list of your contacts.

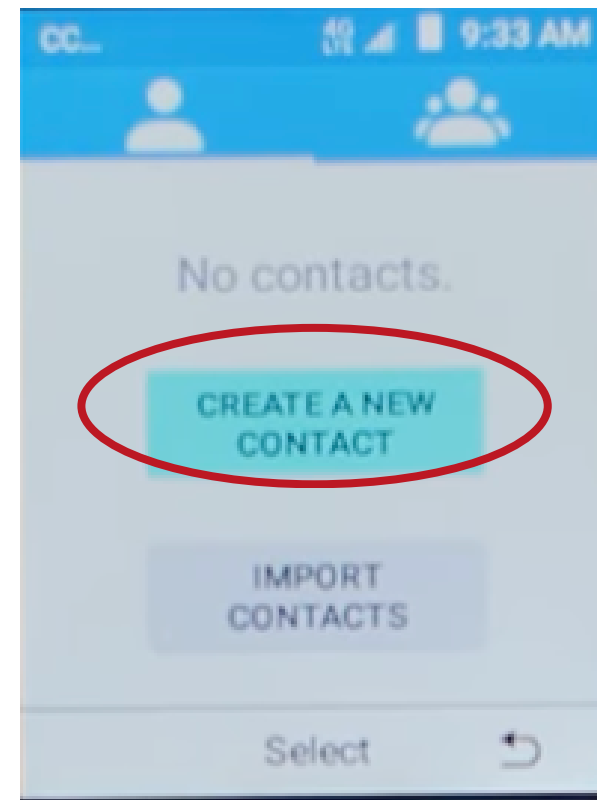

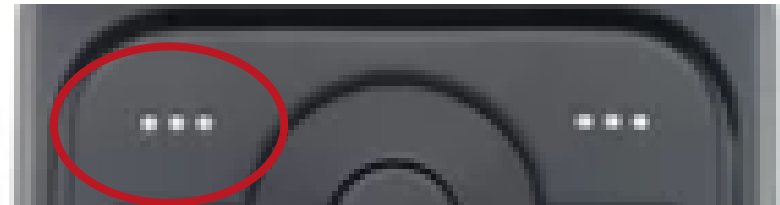



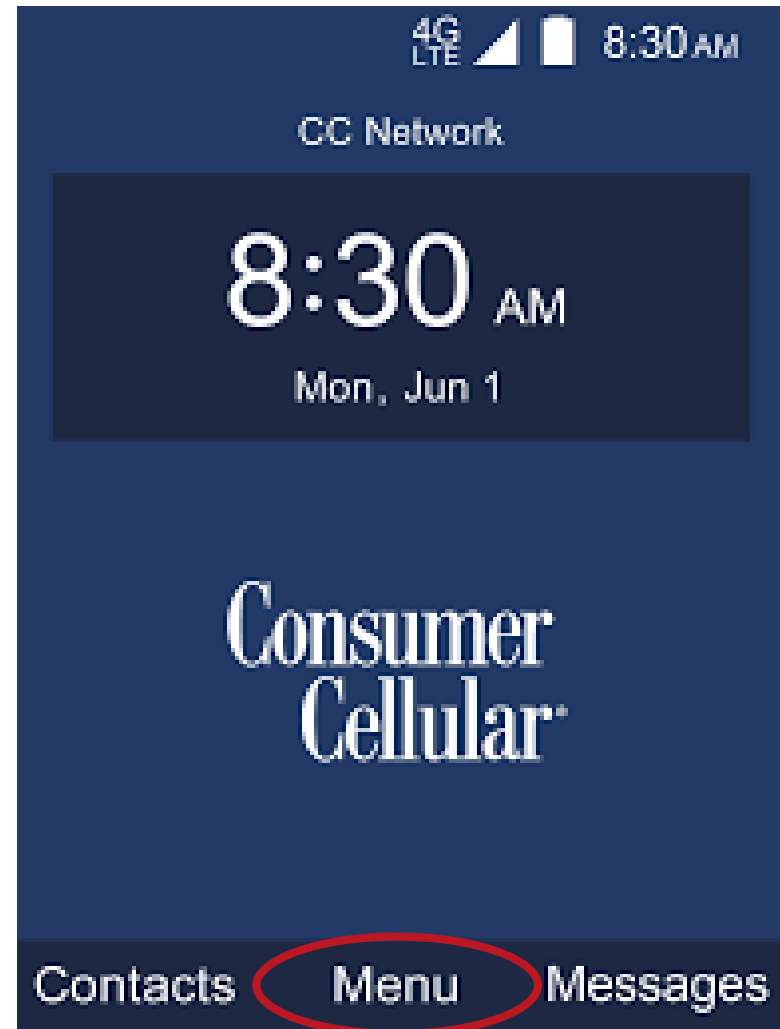

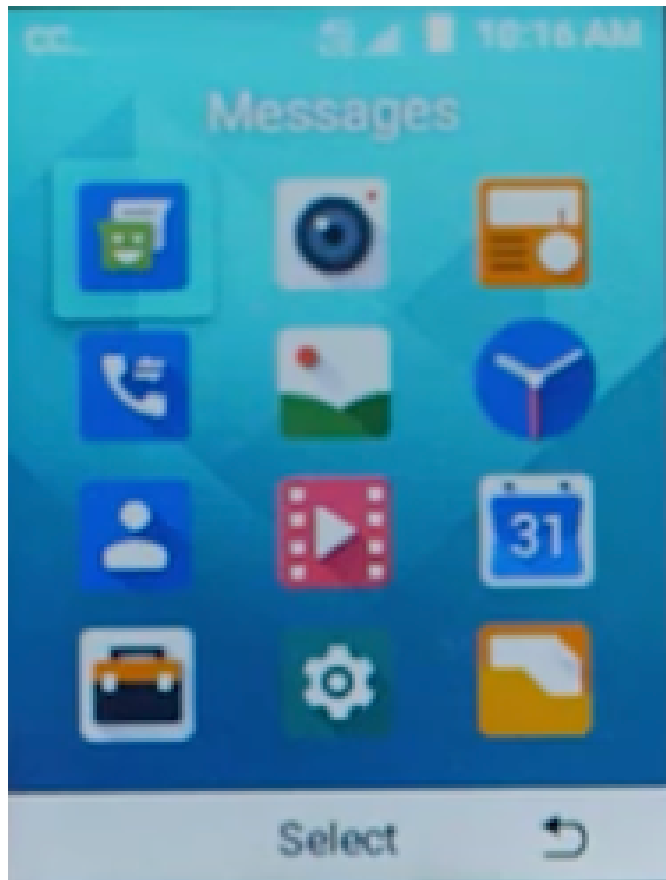

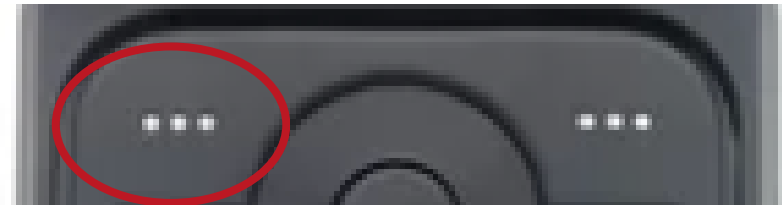

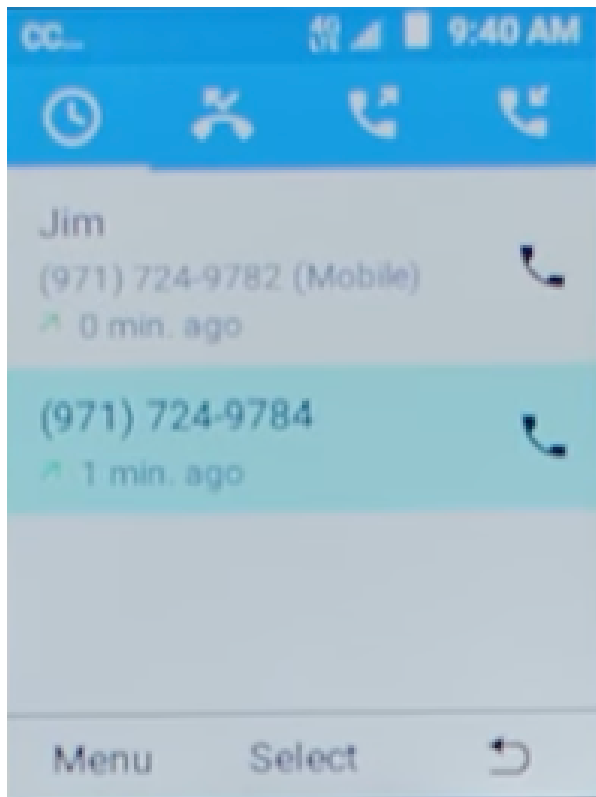

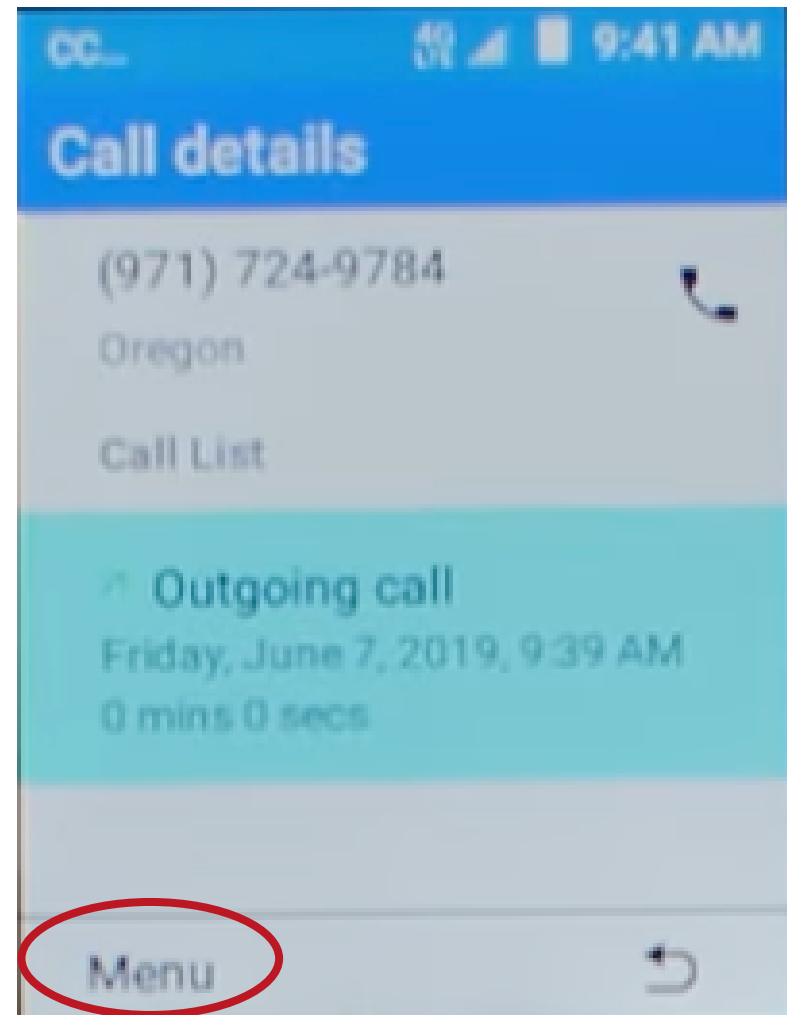

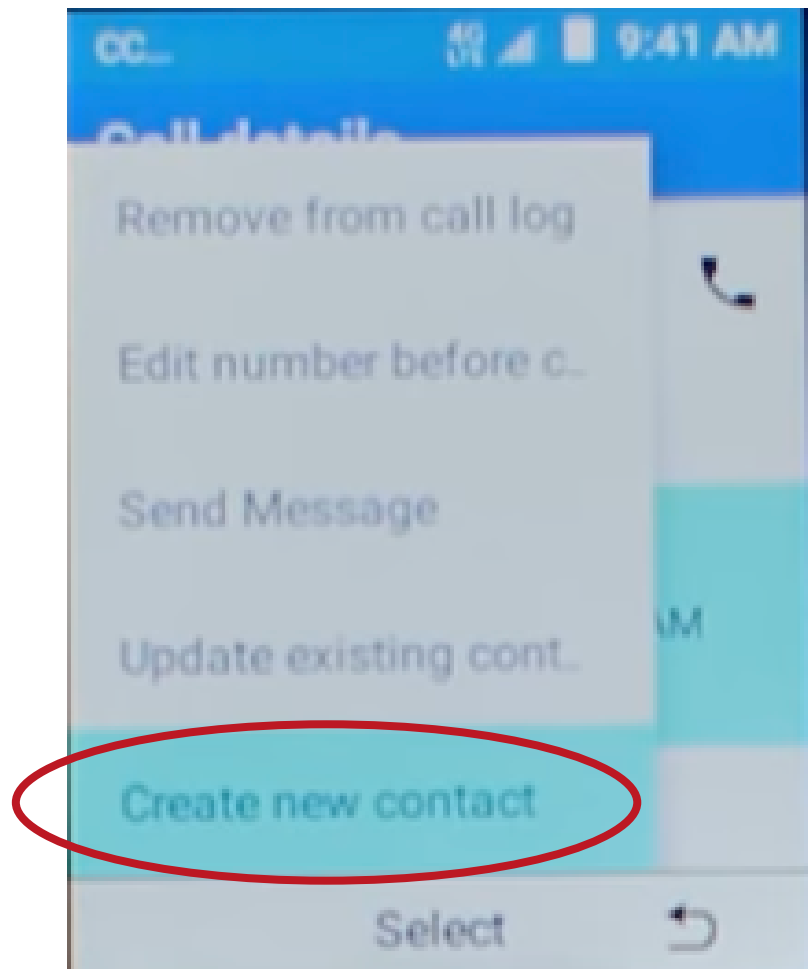

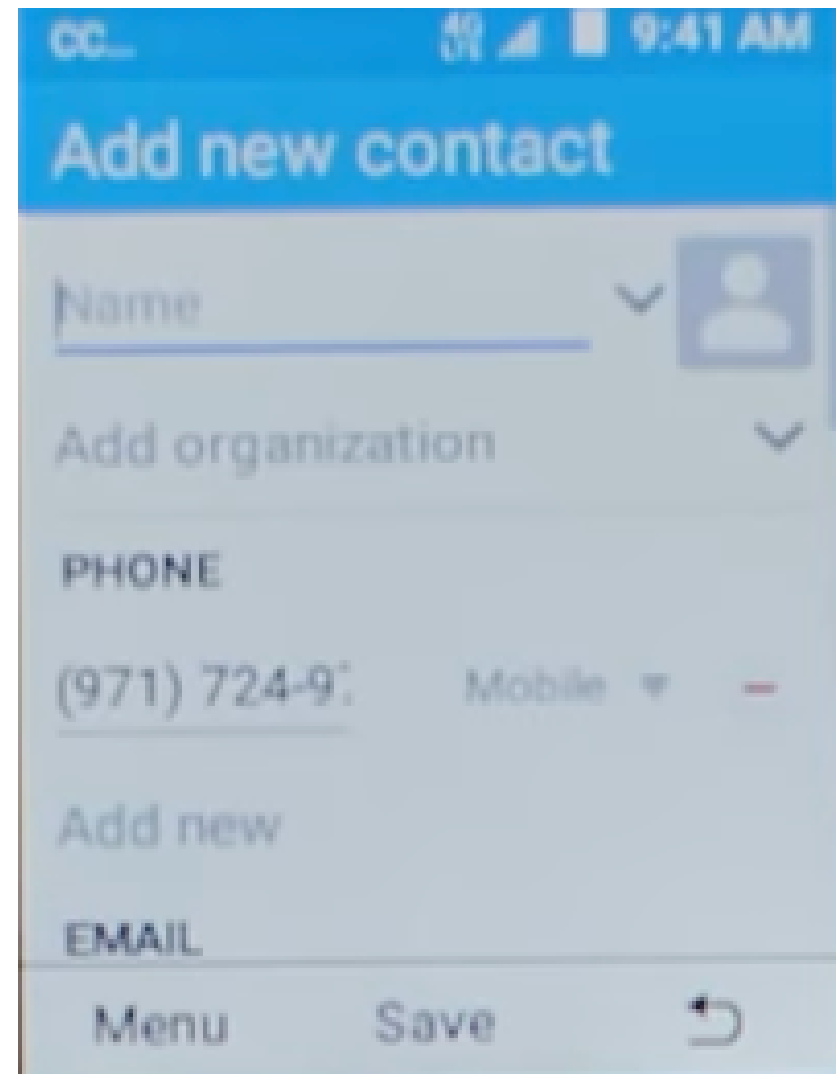

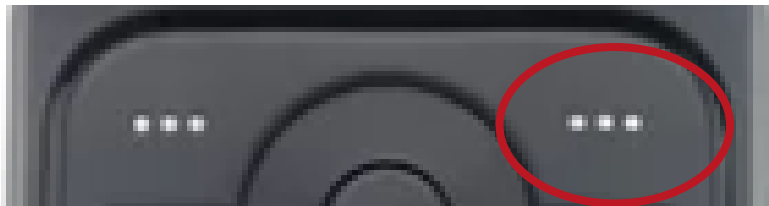

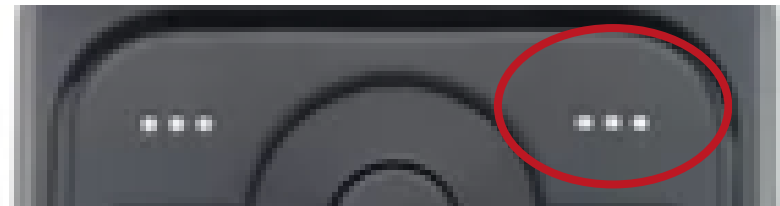
Sending a Message Step 1 37

1. Sending messages allows you to communicate with people in your device's contacts as well as new numbers. First, press the right soft key (described in pg. 8) to open the Messages app.



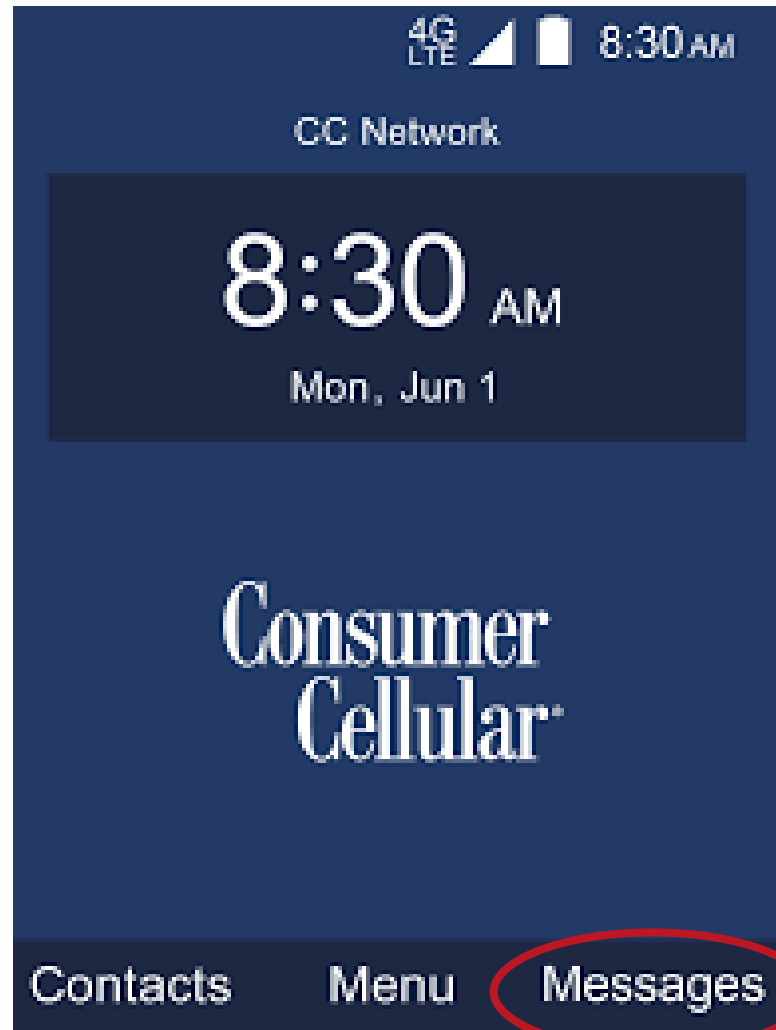

2. Press the right soft key again to open the "Options" menu.



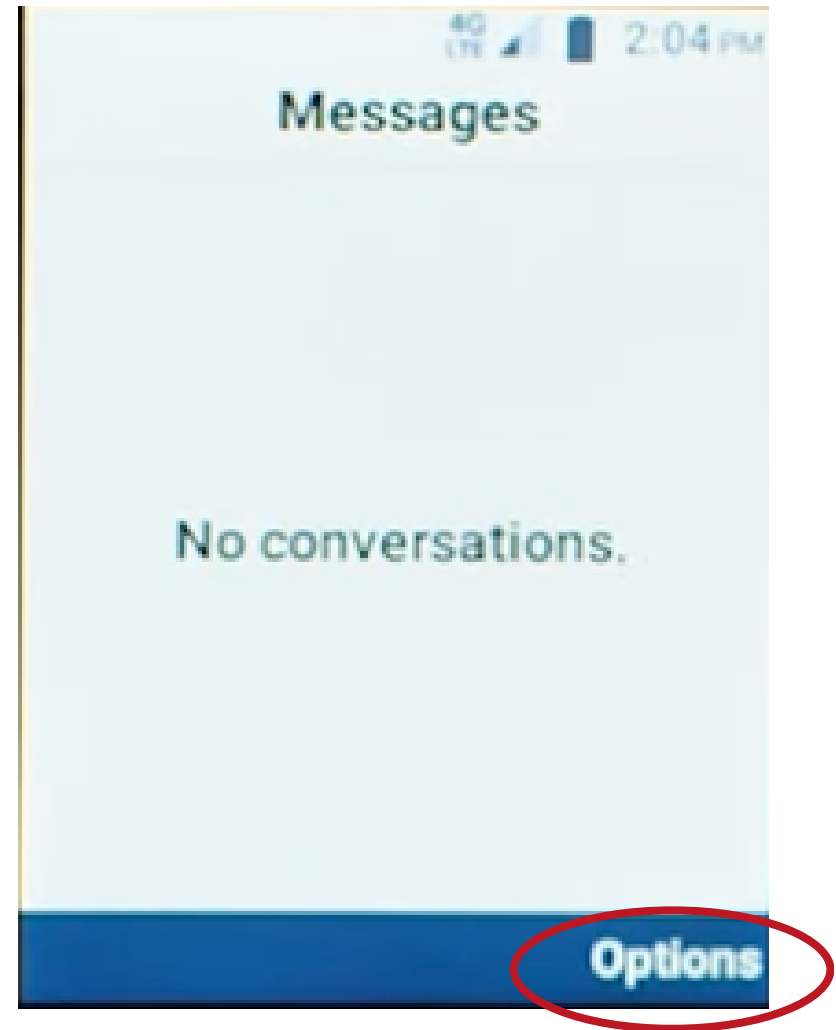

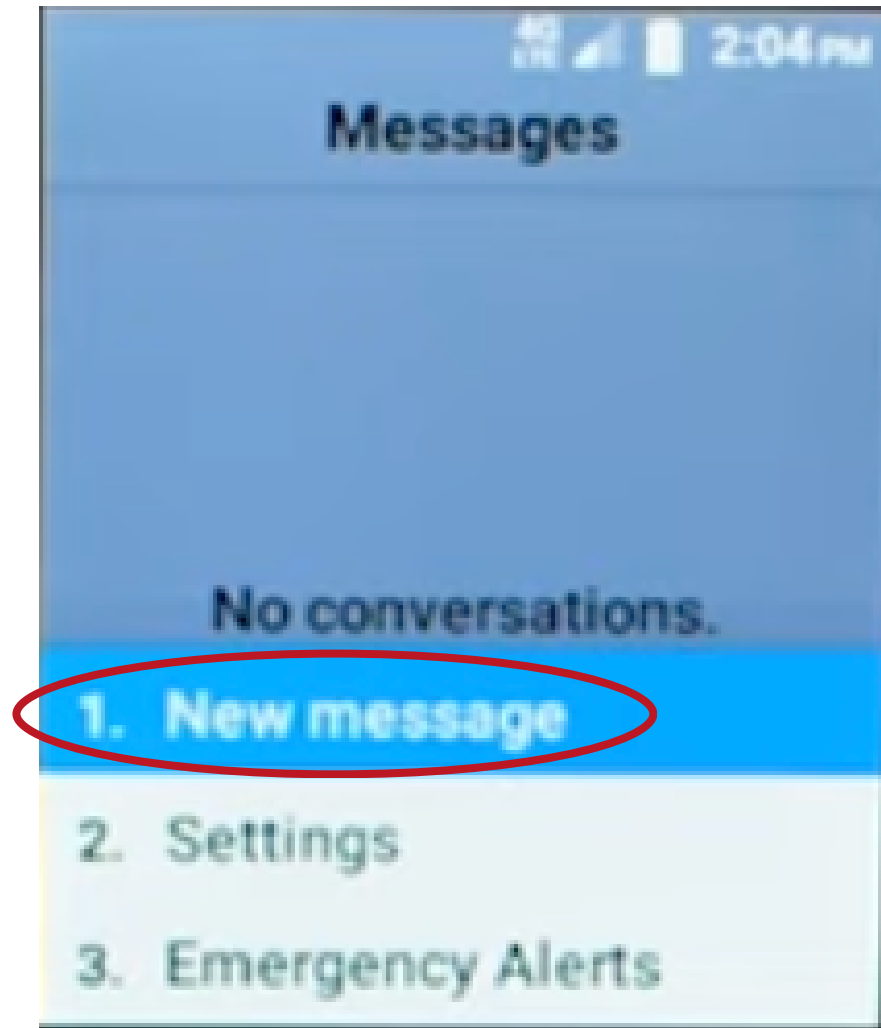

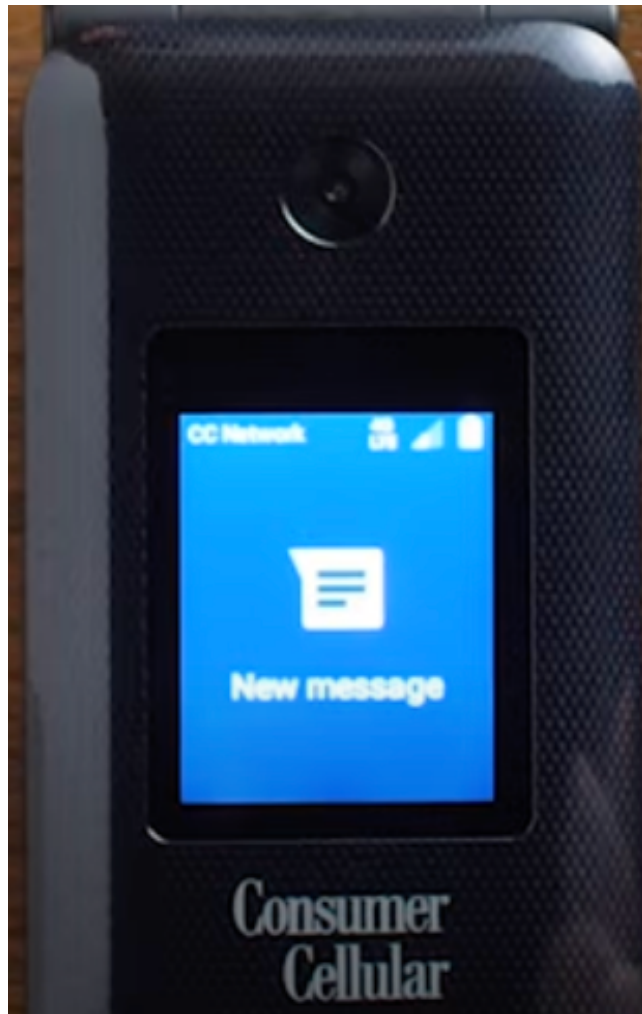

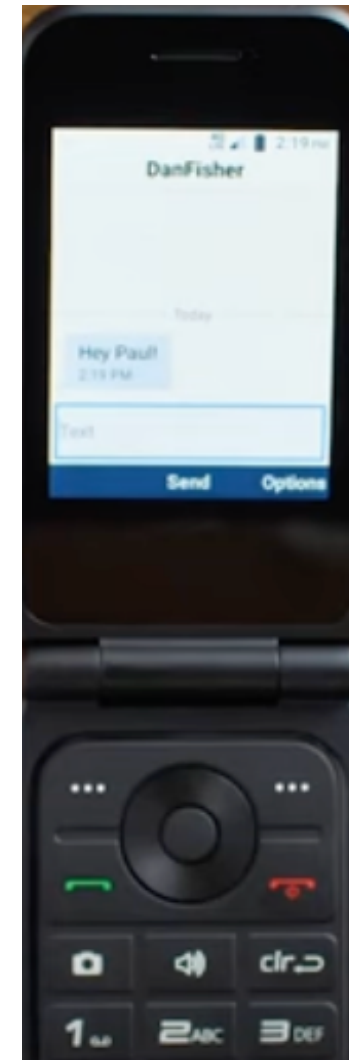

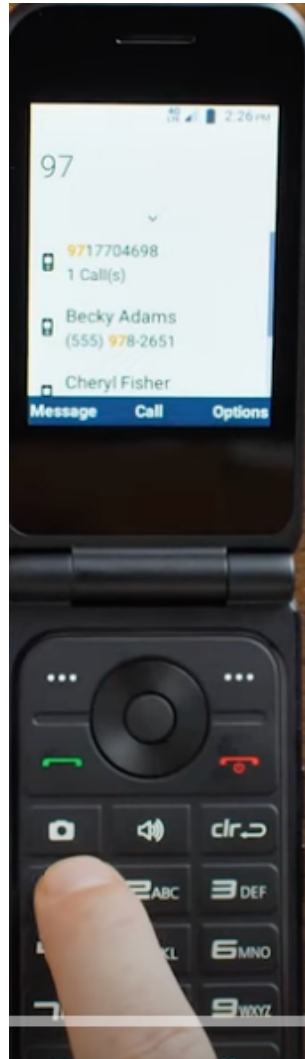

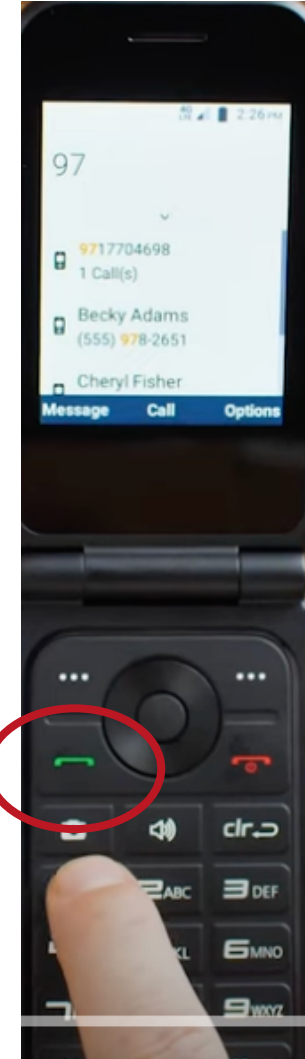

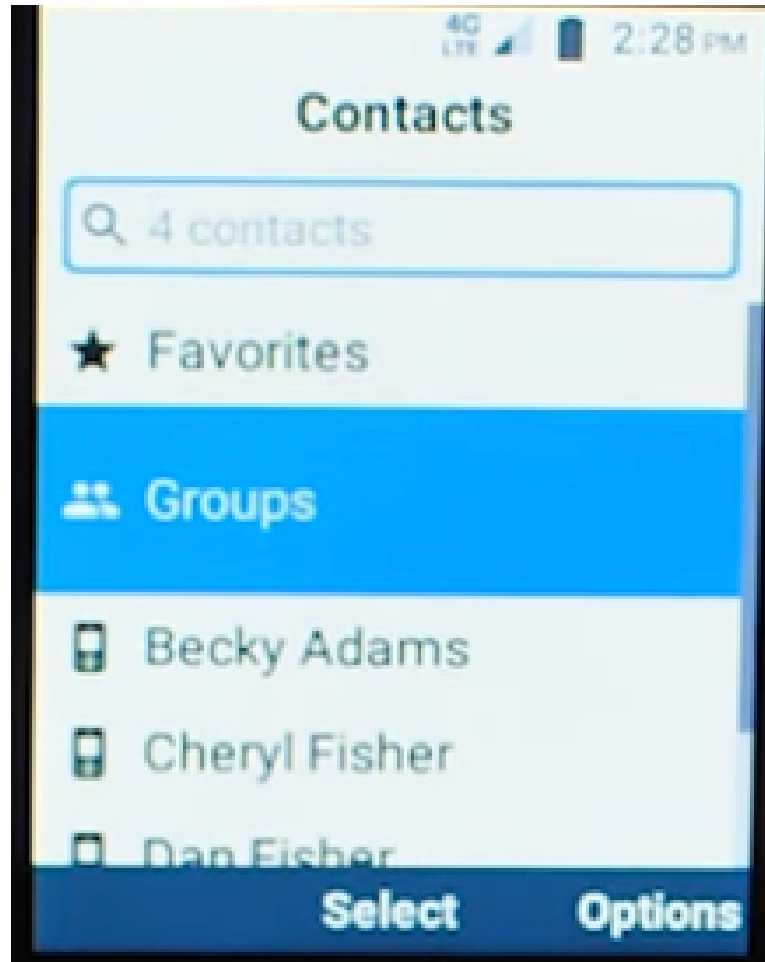

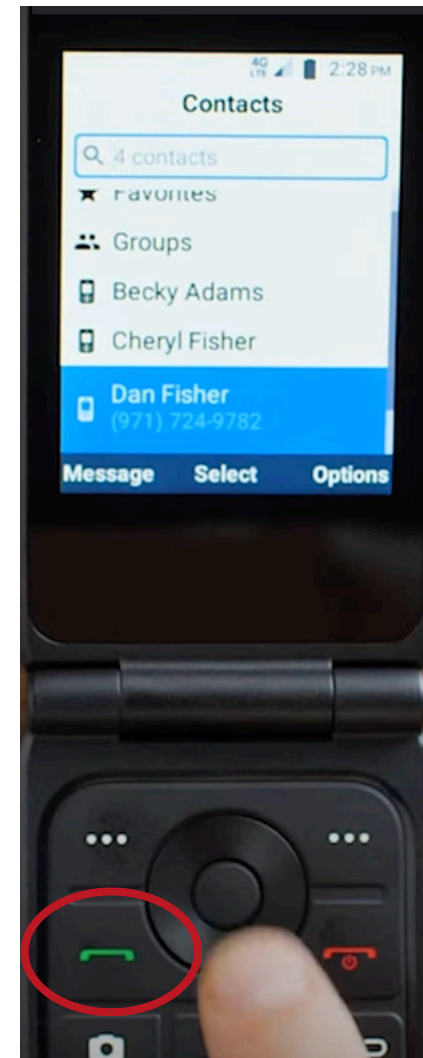

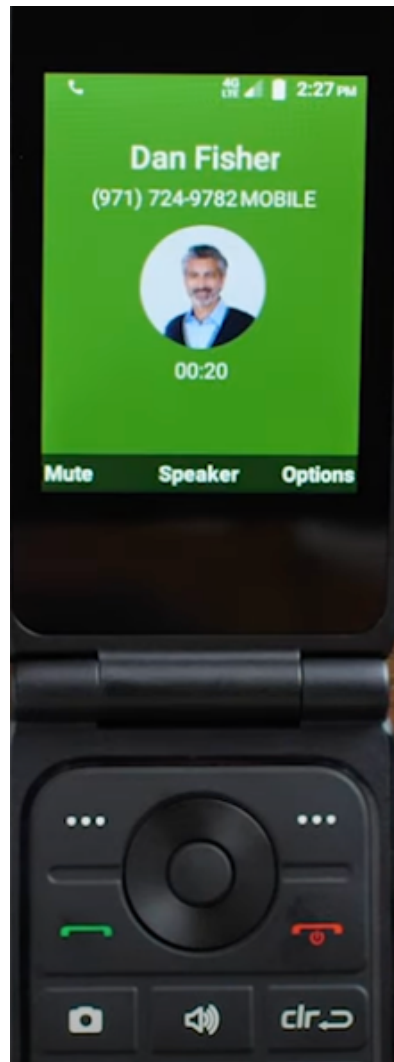

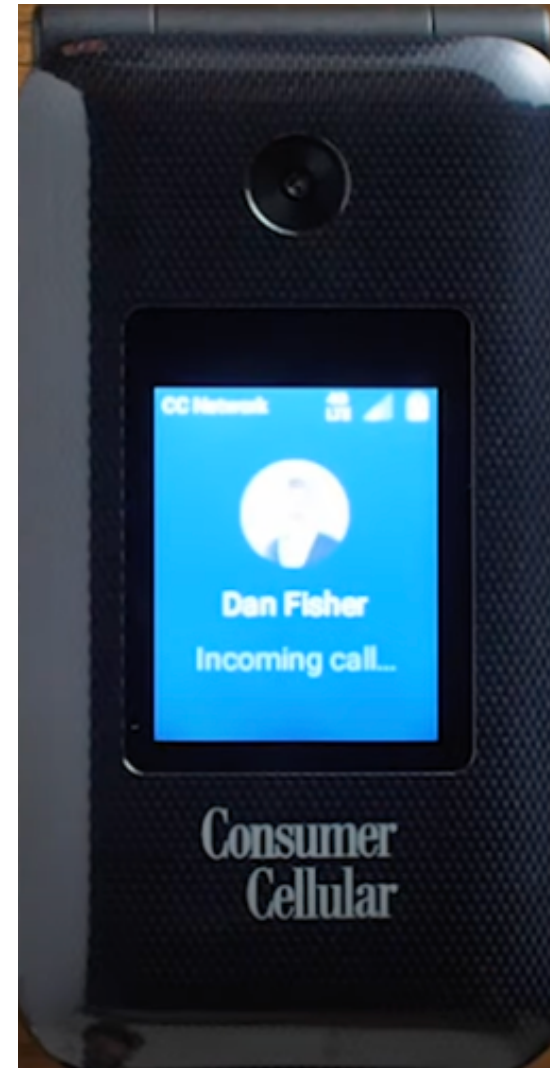

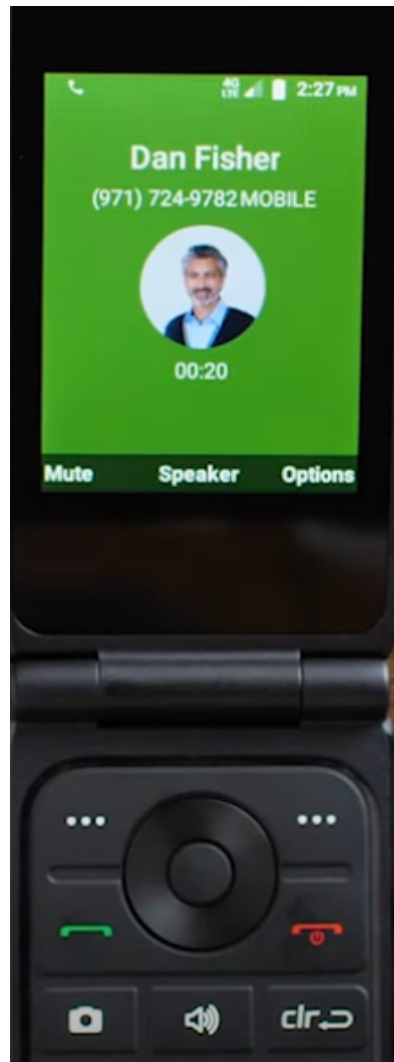
